At risk of history repeating itself, **IBH** was able to step in and offer support & assistance to Pisey Sok's grandmother in raising Pisey. Through the HOPE FOR THE VILLAGE program in Cambodia, Pisey has a sponsor whose monthly support enables Pisey to attend school & ensures that she & her family are fed. Sponsorship also provides school uniform & supplies, clothing, hygiene items & medical care. Most importantly, because of HOPE FOR THE VILLAGE Pisey Sok is learning about Jesus!
